What is Ignite? Ignite is a volunteer program that provides ski, snowboard, cross-country ski, and other snow sport lessons to people with physical, cognitive, or developmental disabilities.

For whom? High school students ages 16 - 18 are eligible to be junior instructors.

Where is it? Eldora Mountain Resort.

Why do it? Ignite is a fun and meaningful way to log community service hours, build your resume for college, develop your snowsport skills, and to share your love of the outdoors.

How can I volunteer?

- Alpine ski or snowboard instructors (help with on-slope lessons)
- Nordic ski instructors (help with on-mountain nordic lessons)
- Equipment (set up adaptive ski equipment)

How do I get started?

- Attend ONE orientation at the Boulder JCC at 6007 Oreg Ave (Arapahoe & Cherryvale):
 - Wednesday, October 16th, 6 pm – 8 pm
 - Saturday, October 19th, 10 am – 12 pm
 - Tuesday, October 22nd, 6 pm – 8 pm

What is the commitment?

- Attend one orientation and create a volunteer account on the website
- Junior Instructor training on Sunday, Nov. 3, 6:30PM at Lucky's Table Mesa
- Complete 1 classroom clinic in November and 2 full-day, on-snow clinics at Eldora in December
- Volunteer at Eldora FIVE or more full days from January to March 2020. You pick the days.
